PLANNING WORKSHOP:

Resolution No. 7421 – Strategic Plan – This workshop was the fourth of a series of meetings facilitated by Marilyn Manning and Elaine Schmitz, of The Consulting Team, LLC. in support of the development of the City’s Strategic Plan document for the next three years. Ms. Manning led the discussion with a page by page review of the proposed document. City Council remarks and suggested edits resulted in nine changes to the primary focus area objectives and planned activities for the City of Redlands 2014-2017 Strategic Plan. To allow more time for public review and reaction, consensus agreed that the Plan, with the incorporated changes, should be presented for adoption at the next regular meeting of the City Council scheduled for July 1, 2014.
