Presentation by Scott Welsh, representing the Redlands Bicycle Classic, Jerry Page and Artist Kathleen King-Page discussing the history of the artwork and the Artist willingness to have the art publicly displayed within the City of Redlands.

**5. NEW BUSINESS**

**A. Discussion and possible action related to acceptance of a donation of artwork titled “Peloton Takes the Curve” from Kathleen King-Page**

Staff discussed the offer to donate the subject artwork and provided two potential locations for the Commission to review: 1) Simonds Parkway at Garden St and Rossmont Dr. and 2) Smiley Park along Cajon Street between Police Annex and Frontier Building

Commissioner Rodriguez provided the history of Mr. and Mrs. Simonds and the development of the existing Simonds Parkway.

The Commission approved the project and recommended that the City Council authorize the donation from Kathleen King-Page of a painted steel artwork titled *Peloton Takes the Curve* and recommended the piece be installed in Smiley Park, next to the police annex building, adjacent to Cajon Street with a motion by Vice Chair Gohman, seconded by Commissioner McGrail and carried.
